If you're just starting to learn how to make jewellery your tutor will guide you in some simple projects that you can complete by the end of the term.

For those with some jewellery making experience - It's an opportunity to finish off projects started in previous terms or perhaps try out that technique you never got around to with one-on-one tutor guidance.
